

Know all men By These preafents That I Sufannah Indian Woman Wid^o of farmington alis Tunksafepus in The County of Hartford & Colony of Conecticott in Newengland That for y^e Sum of Twelve pounds money in hand Rec^d of adam Indian of s^d farmington & Therefore do give grant Sel & Confirm Unto him Said Adam Indian his heires & afignes forever one Sertain Track of Land Sittuate Lying within y^e Township of s^d farmington Containing about Three acres & half of Land Lying on y^e backside of Paqabuck meadow West from y^e Indian Wigwoms on y^e West Side of y^e highway Runing by y^e Comon fence Lying in Length on y^e South Side 30 Rods in Length on y^e north Side 27 Rods in Length weadth at y^e West End 13 Rods at y^e East End 10 in weadth which is bounded East on ^{highway} ~~Comon Land~~ west on an old Ditch South with Land Under y^e Improvement of Cusk & Solomon Indians North on Indian Comon Land To have & to hold said Said given & granted preamifes with y^e appertenances Thereof Unto him y^e s^d adam Indian & Unto his heires & afignes To his & Their own proper Use & behoof moreover I y^e s^d Sufannah Sqaw do hereby for my Selfe heires Exctr^s & adminif^{ts} Covenant with him y^e Said adam Indian That at y^e Time of y^e Enfealing & delivery of these preafents I am well Siefed of s^d given & granted preamifes as good Indefeazable Eftate In fee fymple & That I have good Right In my Sett to give & grant y^e Same In manner & form as is above writte & that y^e Same is free of all Incumbrances of Title Whatsover allso I y^e Said Sue Sannah Squaw do hereby bind my Self heires whatsoever forever hereafter to Warrant Secuer & defend s^d given & granted preamifes Unto him y^e s^d Adam Indian & Unto his heires & afignes againft all Claimes & demands Whatsoever in Witnefs Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seale y^e 14th day of march AD 174⁶/7
