

Upon y<sup>e</sup> Memorial of Hezekiah Wadsworth of Farmington, praying for y<sup>e</sup> Appointment of a Committee vested with full Power to dispose of a certain Indian Right of Land, situated in Farmington & purchased with y<sup>e</sup> avails of y<sup>e</sup> East Haven Right of Land so called, or at least so much thereof as shall be found to belong to John Adams an Indian Native removed with his Family from s<sup>d</sup> Farmington into y<sup>e</sup> Mohawks Country, as p Memorial on File. –

Resolved by this Assembly that Col John Strong M<sup>r</sup> Elnathan Gridley & M<sup>r</sup> Timothy Root be & they are hereby appointed a Committee with full Power & Authority by Sale to dispose of any Propriety or Proprieties of s<sup>d</sup> Right of Land upon Application of y<sup>e</sup> Proprietor or Proprietors giving s<sup>d</sup> Committee Satisfaction of his or their Determination to leave this State, appropriating y<sup>e</sup> Avails of y<sup>e</sup> Lands so disposed of to y<sup>e</sup> sole Use & Benefit of him or them, & in his or their Names to execute a Deed or Deeds to y<sup>e</sup> Purchaser or Purchasers & to do every other Matter or thing necessary to render y<sup>e</sup> Conveyance valid in y<sup>e</sup> Law
