Indians being Remnant of the Pequot Tribe of Indians resident in North Stonington in Said County Humbly Sheweth That your Petitioners have a [ crossout ] reservation of about 400 acres of Land lying in said North Stonington. That Ezra Hewitt Esq. of Said North Stonington has been overseer of Said Tribe for about five years That said overseer lives about three miles from us, is a single man, often from house rarely Comes to See any of us in Sickness or or in health. That our Land if family rented would yield an annual income which would add much to our Comfort especially in Cases of Sickness - but that Said overseer has much of the time Since his appointment rented Said Land to his brother and often for lefs than others were willing to give, and has to managed what he has received that hittle or nothing has been paid or expended for our benefit. We therefore Pray that Ayour Honors would Inquire into Said facts & if found true that Said Overseer may be removed and Some meet Person to be overseer and take Charge of our affairs, and would name Charles Wheeler or Gurdon S. Crandall Esqrs would be persons agreeable to us & we believe would manage for our good. & we as in duty bound shall pray-Dated at North Stonington 27: Janry, 1841 his Thomas X Shelly X Samuel Shuntaup mark her his Polly X Shelly Cyrus + Shelly mark mark her Clarry + Shelly X her mark Sarah X Pomp her mark Prudence + Pauheag. mark Hannah M ned Son his Lemuel + Shelly mark
